HIGH TIME SAIL SNORKEL & BEACH (Code: GRE01)



It's Adventure Time when you board your catamaran, High Time for a snorkel and Beach experience. Sail along the coastline to the Molinere Underwater Statue Park or to the Flamingo Bay Marine Park. The crew will give you the orientation briefing before leading you on an underwater journey. After snorkeling, High Time sails off to Grand Anse beach. Sunbathe, or relax on the beach all to the strains of Caribbean Calypso Music before returning to your ship.

Please note: Rum Punch, bottled water and sandwiches are complimentary. Guests must be able to walk unaided. All participating guests will be required to sign a waiver which may only be available in English. Beach chairs and umbrellas are available for rent onsite for an additional cost. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada. The captain will determine the snorkelling destination based on weather conditions, selecting either the Molinere or Flamingo Bay Marine Park.

SOMETHING SPECIAL



AROUND THE ISLE OF SPICE (Code: GRE02)



Discover the scents and aromas of the "Isle of Spice" on this full day sightseeing tour by motor coach. Your driver will follow the west coast, rich in history and colour. Your first stop will allow you to discover the natural pool of Concord Fall. There, you will spend approximately 30 minutes and observe a very particular type of plantation. Here, the nutmeg and cocoa trees grow along the flanks of the hills in the tropical forest that nearby. Your spice discovery will continue at the Diamond Chocolate factory in Victoria which produces the Jouvay chocolate. You will spend approximately 30 minutes here and have the chance to learn how chocolate (tree to bar) is produced and exported. A chocolate tasting will conclude this visit. The tour then continues to the views over Grenada's Grenadine islands, once home to the Carib Indians on the island. By now, you're ready for lunch in Belmont Estate, a plantation house, where you will spend approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes to taste some typical Creole dishes while enjoying a view of the Estate. To end this day, you will return to the pier through the rain forest over the mountains with a 30 minute stop at Grand Etang, home of the Mona monkey, where you can take a short walk of the surrounding gardens. An approximately 30 minute drive back to the ship brings this tour to a dose.

SCENIC ROUTE



CREOLE BUS SENSATION (Code: GRE03)



Originally British, the Creole buses were the first large means of transportation on the island in the 50's. Neglected and forgotten over the course of the years due to the competition of modern transport, they are currently making their comeback to provide you with the opportunity of savouring how Grenada was in the early days! Nothing has changed: bright colours, and padded wooden benches. So, off we go for a truly local cocktail. Grenada's capital is British in nature with the Carenage, a little harbour set in the hollow of an ancient volcano. This is our point of departure from where we launch ourselves in the assault of St George's. It is indeed a bit of a climb to reach the heights of Grenadian history; we are on our way to the panoramas that can be admired at Fort Frederick which overlooks the small capital. Its ancient stones and rocks tell the tale of the culture shock between England and France in the old days. Fort Frederick, stands dominant above the tropical rainforest and the Caribbean Sea, offering you a stop with a panoramic view of 360 degree. Leaving Fort Frederick behind, head to the south of the island, "surfing" the hill tops, as the bus follows the road along the tropical hills and slides down the Grenadian countryside. You will then arrive at Quarantine Point for a photo stop with a view of the bays of Grand Anse and Morne Rouge before going to the beach for a one hour stop, with your feet in the water, your head below the sea grape trees and a rum punch in your hand. A short drive to return to the cruise terminal will end this tour. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate.

Please note: Maximum weight is 90 kilos. Beach chair available for rent at an additional cost. Guests must be in good health to climb the forts; however, they can stay in the bus during the visit. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada.

NATURAL WONDERS



CHOCOLATE & FALLS (Code: GRE05)



This island tour will allow you to get to know everything about the "Jouvay" organic chocolate production at the Diamond Chocolate Factory nested in the village of Victoria on the west coast of Grenada. You'll find it in an 18th-century converted rum distillery, which was built by French monks. Nowadays, the factory's responsible for making Jouvay'. This chocolate's completely organic and you'll learn how it's made - from the harvest of the cocoa beans, to watching them dry on trays under the Caribbean sun. A visit to the garden of cocoa trees to see, cocoa, cloves, chili, nutmeg, flowers, fruits, followed by a chocolate tasting, will conclude this visit. On your way back, you will stop for approximately 30 minutes at the natural pool at the Concord Falls. Here the nutmeg and cocoa trees grow along the flanks of the hills in the tropical forest that is forever near. Weather permitting, you may even have the opportunity to enjoy a quick dip in the water before returning to the ship. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Please note: Guests are advised to wear a swimsuit under a cover-up, bring sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses, and a towel. The order of the stops may vary. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada. Swimming in the falls is weather-dependent and cannot be guaranteed.

SOMETHING SPECIAL



RUM & BEACH (Code: GRE06)



The natural beauty of Grenada is what makes the island so unique. Your first stop is at Clark's Court, a rum distillery and an interesting historical site in Grenada. The factory has been in operation since 1937 and is situated in the southern part of the island, in the Parish of St. George's. Your guide will explain all the different processes and stages of making the rum. You would learn about the distilling process from sugar cane, syrup and molasses, to rum, and also the aging, blending and bottling process of making rum. On this tour you will also get the opportunity to discover old steam engines, some dating as far back as 1886 that are still used. Then you are invited to sample the rums at the sample bar. You will be given recipes on different ways you can mix the rum so that you can appreciate the taste of these fine products. Leaving the Rum Distillery, you will travel to a secluded beach. There, you will enjoy paddling in the water with a complimentary drink in your hand, for approximately two hours. There are restroom facilities with changing rooms, and showers onsite. Guests must be at least 10 years old to participate.

SIGHTSEEING & TROPICAL BEACH TOUR (Code: GRE09)



Grenada's capital is British in nature with the Carenage, a little harbour set in the hollow of an ancient volcano. This is your point of departure from where you launch yourselves in the assault of St George's. It is a bit of a climb to reach the heights of Grenadian history; you are on your way to the panoramas that can be admired from Fort Frederick which overlooks the small capital. Its ancient stones and rocks tell the tale of the culture shock between England and France in the old days. It stands dominant above the Caribbean Sea, offering a panoramic view of 360 degrees. Leaving Fort Frederick, you will reach the South Point of Grenada to a beach, where, with your feet in the water, your head below the sea grape trees and a rum punch in your hand, you will spend approximately two hours before returning to your ship. CUI TURE AND HISTORY



GRAND ETANG & FORT FREDERICK TOUR (Code: GRE14)



Get the historical and geographical highlights on this tour of Grenada. Enjoy a narrated drive through the capital of St. George's en route to Grand Etang National Park and visit the Grand Etang visitor center which has a few displays explaining the local foliage, fauna and history. Needless to say, the views are exceptional. Grand Etang is a crater lake surrounded by a lush tropical forest and is part of the nature reserve. The scenery is breathtaking, with the chance to see a fascinating cross-section of the flora and fauna which make up this rain forest. Then, en route to Fort Frederick, where this historic fort offers a fantastic view of the town and the hardor

Please note: Fort Frederick visit is not suitable for guests with limited mobility and is not wheelchair accessible. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada.

CITY TOUE



PANORAMIC DRIVE OF THE SOUTH OF GRENADA (Code: GRE23)



Enjoy a drive in the south of Grenada. Your journey begins with a visit of Saint George's, the capital of Grenada. This charming Caribbean town sits on the perimeter of the island's natural harbor. Founded in the early 18th century by the French, St. George's Still has some of the character of a French town, which is evident in the red tiled roofs and pastel colours of its buildings. Then, you will pass by the Corniche du Morne Jaloux road, passing Fort Frederick towards the village of Woburn to admire the coastal views of the East Side of the island. You will then arrive at Quarantine Point for a photo stop for a view of the bays of Grand Anse and Morne Rouge before returning to the cruise terminal.

Please note. This two-hour tour is designed to be a scenic overview for guests who prefer shorter excursions with minimal walking. Camouflage dothing is not permitted in Grenada.

NATURAL WONDERS



FORT FREDERICK RAINFOREST AND FALLS (Code: GRE24)



Your sightseeing journey begins with a drive through the town of St. George's, the capital of Grenada, en route to Fort Frederick, an 18th-century fortress that offers panoramic views of St. George's harbor. It is perched atop Richmond Hill and was built by two nations. The French started it in 1779 and the British completed it in 1791 during the French revolution. Next is Grand Etang National Park, enjoy a complimentary beverage while taking in views of the lake that is located in the crater of an extinct volcano. With a bit of chance, you may meet the Mona Monkey who elected home in this area. Then head to Annandale Falls that features a short but steep walk down to where the rushing water is framed by hanging ferns and a variety of the island's flowering and medicinal plants. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. The tour sequence may vary. One complimentary drink per person is included in the tour. It is advisable that guests bring a bottle of water from the ship. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada. Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed.

SCENIC ROUTE



OUTBACK OPEN SAFARI TRUCK TOUR (Code: GRE25)



This excursion is loaded with views and intriguing spots, all presented to you in your open-air safari truck. Travel from the cruise terminal into the heart of the bustling town of St. George's, onto the village of Tanteen. Continue up to Lowthers Lane, with scenic views of the port, the historic Fort George, and the Parliament building. Your first stop will be at Fort Frederick - be sure to take in the scenery that surrounds you. Then you will take a detour inland through agricultural villages to the historic Battlehill. Travel through the town of Grenville, onto the Grand Etang Crater Lake and Welcome Center and capture more photographic memories. This experience will keep you entertained with the history and cultural gem that is Grenada. Guests must be at least 6 years old to participate.

Please note: The minimum age to participate is 6 years old. The type of vehicle used on this tour is an open-air safari truck. This is not a self-driven tour; a driver will be provided. The driver of this tour is also the guide. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada.

SCENIC ROUTE



PROTECTOURS: DOWNTOWN ABBEY OF GRENADA AND GARDEN (Code: GRE26)



Spend some time enjoying the Tower Estate, enchanted by all the history inside its mahogany and stone great house. Explore its gardens and enjoy the snack menu made from ingredients grown on the estate. The Tower Estate is known as the Downtown Abbey of Grenada and includes a 107-year-old building surrounded by 1.5 acres of ornamental plants, many of which included in Grenada's gold award winning exhibit at the Chelsea Flower Show each year. Your tour includes a walk through the garden and the house, along with a three-course light menu. Chocolate treats using the famous Grenadian chocolate and the blue tea will be served during the tour. Guests must be at least 8 years old to participate.

Please note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking during the garden tour portion. This tour is recommended for guests who are in good physical condition. Guests are advised to wear comfortable shoes and bring a hat. Guests must be at least 8 years old to participate. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada.

ACTIVE & ADVENTURE



SPEEDBOAT AND SCULPTURE PARK SNORKELING (Code: GRE28)



Right next to where your cruise ship will dock, climb aboard a twin-engine powerboat and head out for your snorkeling adventure. After a short safety briefing, head North along Grenada's sheltered western coast. During your tour, you will learn about the Spice Isle and the ecology, wildlife, geography, and local history of Grenada. The boat will stop for approximately 40 minutes so that you can explore the underwater sculpture park of Grenada, accompanied by your guide. Non-snorkelers are welcome to stay onboard the boat with your Captain. After your snorkel, enjoy a local juice before zooming off for another hour of fun, exploring, and great photo opportunities. Your tour will also visit the historic town of St Georges, where you will cruise the protected inner harbor, before one last blast back to the dock to disembark. Guests must be at least 8 years old to participate

Please note: It is recommended that guests wear a swimsuit, bring a towel, and biodegradable sunscreen. Guests may be required to sign a waiver which may only be available in English. Guests must climb a ladder to get in and out of the water from the boat. The minimum age to participate is 8 years old. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those who suffer from back or neck problems. Guests must be able to swim to participate in the snorkeling. The maximum weight to participate is 275 lbs. A Snorkel mask, fins, and life vest are included for you to use on this tour. Camouflage clothing is not permitted in Grenada.

LA LUNA GOLD DAY PASS - YACHT CLUB EXCLUSIVE (Code: GRE29YC)



After an approximately 30-minute drive from the cruise ship terminal, you'll find nestled into a private hillside on one of Grenada's secluded beaches La Luna, an escape to paradise. You will have approximately 6 hours to make use of the hotel's amenities. Take a dip in the pool, venture onto the beach, and enjoy a lunch. Unwind and relax before heading back to your awaiting cruise ship. Please note: This tour is available for guests booked in the Yacht Club only. The price of this tour is perperson and includes round trip transportation, 2 cocktails, lunch, access to the beach, pool, beach chairs, non-motorized water sports, including snorkel gear, stand up paddleboards, and kayaks (available on a first-come, first-served basis). It is recommended that guests bring sunscreen, towels, a hat, sunglasses, and a bathing suit. Chemical-based sunscreen is not permitted as they are harmful to marine life. Guests are required to bring ocean-safe alternative sunscreen. The transfer to La Luna takes approximately 30 minutes each way. The deadline to cancel this tour without any penalties is 24 hours prior to the call. Any cancellations after this will result in a 100% penalty of the tour price. The transportation to and from La Luna Resort may be shared with other Yacht Club guests. Should you wish to have private roundtrip transportation, please inquire with the shore excursions desk onboard as additional charges may apply.
